The Centre for Genomic Regulation (CRG) is an international biomedical research institute of excellence whose mission is to advance our understanding of the complexity of life from the genome to the cell to a whole organism and its interaction with the environment, offering an integrated view of genetic diseases.

Research at CRG

The breadth of topics, approaches and technologies at the CRG allows us to ask a broad range of fundamental questions in life sciences and biomedicine. Twenty-nine research teams are organized in four programmes: bioinformatics and genomics; systems biology; cell and developmental biology; gene regulation, stem cells and cancer.

Our international research community (more than 350 scientists from 38 countries) is supported by state-of-the-art technologies, ranging from super-resolution microscopy and proteomics to next-generation sequencing.

CRG strategic goals include training the next generation of scientists, establish a dialogue with society, and translate scientific knowledge into benefits for health and value for society.
